



## TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

### ELIGIBILITY

1. As the Mid West Art Prize 2019 (MWAP) is a promotion of Western Australian practising artists, consequently entrants must be residents of Western Australia since September 2017.
2. Entrants can submit a maximum of two artworks.
3. Artworks must have been created within the last twelve months prior to 30 November 2018
4. All artworks submitted cannot have been exhibited prior to being entered into the MWAP.
5. Artworks of any medium will be accepted for entry, except those made from hazardous materials. If you are unsure about the eligibility of your artwork please consult the GRAG team [geraldtonregionalartgallery@cgg.wa.gov.au](mailto:geraldtonregionalartgallery@cgg.wa.gov.au)
6. As the MWAP 2019 is an acquisitive award, all artworks MUST be available for sale (a 33% commission + GST applies).
7. Artworks must be able to fit through the Gallery's 100 x 200cm loading doors.

### APPLICATION

8. A fee of \$40 will apply per work submitted.
9. Entry fees are non-refundable.
10. Entry forms and fees must be received by the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery by 4PM on 30 November 2018.
11. Late entries will not be accepted.
12. The entrant accepts the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery reserves the right to edit the supplied artist statement to ensure editorial consistency with MWAP 2019 promotional material.

### SHORTLISTING

13. Applicants are advised that the MWAP 2019 is a curated exhibition, not all entries will be selected to exhibit.
14. All works entered will be subject to a panel of industry professionals who reserve the right to judge and select work for the MWAP exhibition dependant on a work's overall quality, originality, technique, eligibility and available space.
15. Feedback from this process is unavailable due to the large volume of entries.
16. Unselected applicants will be advised as such by 12 December 2018.
17. Names of selected applicants will be published by the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery by 12 December 2018.





## SALE AND EXHIBITION OF SHORTLISTED ARTWORKS

18. Sale prices of entered works must include GST and the City of Greater Geraldton's 33% Sales Commission.
19. Sets or multiples entered as one work will not be sold as separate pieces.
20. If the entrant does not currently hold an ABN, they will be required to fill out a Statement by a Supplier form upon selection.
21. Upon the sale of an artwork, the artist will receive payment for works sold within 30 days of CGG receiving payment from the Purchaser.
22. As the MWAP 2019 is an acquisitive award, the overall winning work shall become the property of the CGG Art Collection. The same conditions apply to prize-winning works in other categories, the artwork becomes the property of the sponsor of the prize.
23. Shortlisted works may not be displayed to the entrant's exact specifications. Works will be exhibited by the discretion of the Curator.
24. All shortlisted works must be ready for display, equipped with tabs or 'D' rings. The Gallery has a range of standardised plinths for free standing sculptures, anything specialised will have to be supplied by the artist.
25. Special display requirements must be discussed with the Gallery Coordinator prior to delivery for installation.
26. The Geraldton Regional Gallery will provide insurance on all works selected for exhibition whilst on display.

## DELIVERY OF SHORTLISTED ARTWORKS

27. No artwork is to be delivered to the gallery until individual artists are invited to do so by notification of shortlisting.
28. All shortlisted artworks must be delivered to either the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery or the Perth Metropolitan Pick Up Point on or before 28 January 2019. (Address and further details will be provided to shortlisted entrants).
29. All shortlisted entries must be packed to withstand travel. No responsibility will be taken for works damaged while in transit to or from the Gallery. At the conclusion of the exhibition, the Gallery will pack all works for collection in the provided original packing.
30. Artists are to arrange and meet all the cost of freight (delivery and return) of the artworks to and from the Perth pick up point or the Geraldton Regional Art Gallery.
31. All unsold artworks from the MWAP 2019 exhibition must be pick up from Geraldton Regional Art Gallery or the Perth Metropolitan Pick Up Point on or before 1 April 2019. (Address and further details to be advised to shortlisted entrants). Please note that ID will be required on Pick Up.

## COPYRIGHT OF SHORTLISTED ARTWORKS

32. The Gallery reserves the right the license to make reasonable reproductions of shortlisted artworks for the limited purpose of publicity, social media and archival reference.
